No ditch was visible but found only vby excavation. Original mound was about 54ft diam and 3ft high with ditch 8-10ft wide and 5-6ft3in deep, quarried in limestone. Causeway to southwest. Secondary barrow was put on top with a slightly greater diameter which spread to 55ft and had a total height including primary mound when excavated of 5ft. Second barrow used original ditch by re-excavation of it cutting through causeway of rock on S.W. and substituting a causeway on east. See Proc. 1951:6,(2):131 and plate XXII.

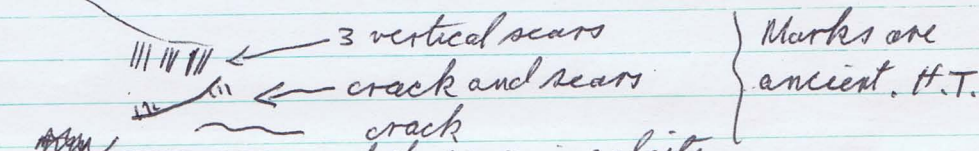
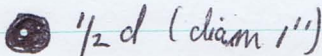
