This tumulus has been completely excavated and proved to be a barrow. The report has not yet been issued, Oct. 1954. Proc. 1951: 6, (2): 119-120 gives brief notes on the structure. It consisted of a cairn with single causewayed ditch with an internal structure round the grave. No measurements are given and the ones above are taken from Proc. 1927:3, (1): 31.
