Perhaps a bell barrow. Structure a cairn. Much hollowed out as a quarry for stones especially on north. Height is given to rim of hollow centre. Sides are steep where intact. Disturbance does not seem to have reached original ground level. Most of stones are limestone and many appear waterworn. Suggestion of a platform 2 ft high all round S. half with berm 4ft wide. No ditch.
