## CAMP RULES

- i) This log book must be written up after each camp and all work done must be recorded.
- ii) No caving clothes may be stored in the hut nor may any person change into or out of caving clothes inside the hut. The clothes shed only, must be used for clothes storage.
- iii) After each camp, the fire must be properly extinguished, the grate cleaned, the wood bunkers filled & the hut ~~swept~~<sup>swept</sup>. All food must be stored in tins ONLY.
- iv) All waste material/s must be removed from the hut (~~by~~ the proper receptacle) & placed in appropriate pit.
- v) Paraffin may not be used to light the fire, although candle ends may be used in times of emergency.

- (i) Parties visiting caves will leave a note stating Persons, destination & time of departure with date, in an obvious position in the hut.
- (ii) It is essential that the hut is properly bolted & shuttered, & the last person to leave will be held responsible in the event of fire through neglect of these precautions.
- (iii) After each camp, bunks must be adjusted so that each has the mattress &/or sleeping bag & fair number of blankets. Personal possessions may not be left on bunks between camps.

- ii) The society may cut for their own use ① birch trees. ② dead wood ③ ash saplings provided that 1 good tree or ash sapling is left at intervals of 4 or 5 feet.
- iii) Trees are to be cut as low to the ground as possible, & in felling it is necessary to arrange that no other trees are damaged by the falling timber.
- iv) Brushwood obtained from the felled trees should not be removed for use or put in safely placed piles





Dike Cave Cakes




OCHRE CAVE







The gale which had raged all night ceased and it rained for only about three quarters of the time, permitting the replenishment of the wood bunkers but causing us to decide to return to Salisbury on Thursday instead of Friday. Three of us left at 2:20 P.M. and explored the abandoned water works tunnel mostly ankle deep in water and went into the end chamber of Aveline's Hole. We then collected some fossils and returned to the hut at 5:20 P.M. We retired to bed about 9:30 P.M.



Stones could be heard falling about 30' by dropping vertically down a narrow shaft about 15' a mass of large boulders was observed. A fairly explosive mix bomb while revealed that all obvious passageways were closed although several could easily be dug out. All passages were not explored as Bob laid no claim to Bristol + only one lamp endeavored to function; the balance of fuses had been prevented by Bob wedging himself ventrically in the entrance.
