

## E. K. TRATMAN — BIBLIOGRAPHY

An attempt is made to present a complete bibliography of the writings of Edgar Kingsley Tratman (1899-1978). For details of his achievements see the obituary notice in *Proc. U.B.S.S.* 15(1), 3-5.

The bibliography runs to over 230 titles, and for reasons of space and convenience of reference it is divided into four parts.

**DENTAL PAPERS** There are 54 publications (amounting to 223 pages) in this section, spanning the years 1930-52. The majority (41) appeared in the *British Dental Journal* and record case histories of dental conditions met with in the course of his practice in Singapore.

**SPELAEOLOGICAL SOCIETY PAPERS** Tratman contributed some 69 papers to the *Proceedings of the University of Bristol Spelaeological Society*, spanning the years from volume 1 in 1922 to volume 15 in 1979. They form the substantial part of his contributions to caving and archaeology, dealing mainly with sites in the Mendip Hills of Somerset and the west of Ireland. They total over 700 pages, excluding illustrations.

**CAVE RESEARCH GROUP PAPERS** Tratman published 38 notes (spanning 69 pages) in the *Cave Research Group Newsletter*; all are very short and most are reviews or comments. Five are duplicated in other publications.

**MISCELLANEOUS PUBLICATIONS** These are miscellaneous only in that they are to be found dispersed through 20 international journals and other publications. The topics dealt with are caving and archaeology. They include chapters in three books and the book which Tratman edited (and indeed was largely responsible for) on the Caves of North-West Clare, Ireland. They also include a few papers on dental aspects of archaeological material published in dental journals.

It is in this last miscellaneous section that there may be gaps and the compiler would welcome information on any omissions. In total the bibliography runs to 232 titles (including 7 duplicates), amounting to around 1500 pages of print over a span of 60 years publishing.

Abbreviations to titles of periodicals mostly follow the *World List of Scientific Periodicals*, except as noted below. Where Tratman has co-authored a publication, the other author(s) are noted, though not necessarily in the order in which they appear in the published work.
