Oliver Lloyd wrote a very large number of, often very short, papers, articles and notes. Many of the shorter items contain significant facts or opinions but do not merit full description. In addition to individual items, he contributed regular series of articles to several publications. These, and also his Mendip Rescue Organization annual reports, his diving reports, and notes on Cave Diving Group administrative matters, are recorded briefly in the later sections of this bibliography, so that all his work can be located while leaving the main listing of more manageable size. Omitted altogether are the many circular letters, minutes and reports written for limited distribution while he was secretary of the Mendip Rescue Organization between 1956 and 1972.
