

## Museum Salvage.

After the total destruction of the Society's museum by fire in November, 1940, it was possible to salvage certain exhibits from the ashes and débris. The following list represents all the objects which it has so far been possible to identify; it is hoped to publish a further list at a later date. A great deal of salvaged material from barrow-sites, Gorsey Bigbury, and the Corston cist, etc., has been stored in a safe place and will be examined and identified as opportunity arises.

Unless otherwise stated, the objects listed are reasonably complete and undamaged, but many have their colour altered by fire, etc. Since the museum's catalogues were also burnt, it is only possible to identify objects by references to illustrations or descriptions in the Society's *Proceedings*.

In the third column, Roman numerals refer to plates, Arabic numerals to the figures illustrating the article on that particular site, or if preceded by "P" to the page on which a description occurs. A figure in brackets in the last column indicates that only a part of the object was recovered.
