

LIBRARY REPORT

The payment by the Board of Trade of a sum in settlement of the Society's claim for War Damage has enabled the Committee to authorise substantial purchases, and the items added to the library, together with those still on order, will in a great measure complete the replacement of books lost through enemy action.
