Brean Down Sand Cliff Site

July 1975. Mr. A.S. ApSimon reports that the intrasive Dark Age cemetery has been dated at around 650 A.D.

The bone from the BONE BED, layer 11A, contains no collagen and so is useless for C14 dating. The same applies to bone from King Arthur's Ceve, W2, Wye Valley and to Picken's Hole, Layer 7. The date for the Brean Down layer would be Mid-Devensian

The destruction of the collagen presumes a long exposure to weathering.

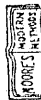
