This may be a tumulus. It has an oval hollow centre. The depression does not go below the level of the ground outside thus suggesting that it is not a mine working. It is on sloping ground. It is slightly oval due to the recent use of a bulldozer over the area. (1953) It is about as far to east of Read's Cavern as T7 is to the west and T7 a proved barrow is also on sloping ground.
