Westbury -on-Trym ?

Planted with fir trees known as the Seven Sisters. In 1923 these reduced to six. Tumulus has flat top. It has been claimed that it cannot be a tumulus as it is on a filled in quarry site. The edge of the quarry can easily be traced still and lies to the south and east of the barrow.
